1. Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

Elite Energy ECO Ltd is fully committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050, in line with the UK Government's legally binding target under the Climate Change Act 2008 (as amended). As a carbon neutral business, we have already offset our current operational emissions and are working to reduce them at source year on year.

Carbon reduction is not simply a compliance obligation for Elite Energy — it is the foundation of our commercial purpose. Our core business is the installation of energy efficiency measures, low-carbon heating systems and renewable energy technologies that directly reduce the carbon emissions of the homes and buildings we work in. Through our delivery of government-funded programmes including ECO4, the Boiler Upgrade Scheme (BUS), the Warm Home Discount (WHD) scheme and the Warm Homes Plan, we have helped thousands of households reduce their energy bills and their carbon footprints.

We recognise the need for businesses to take responsibility for their own emissions as well as those within their supply chains, and we are committed to continuous improvement across all three Scopes.

2. Baseline Emissions Footprint

Elite Energy ECO Ltd has assessed its greenhouse gas emissions across all three Scopes in accordance with the GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard. Our baseline year is the financial year ending November 2024.

3. Emissions Reduction Targets

Elite Energy ECO Ltd has set the following targets for reducing its greenhouse gas emissions:

4. Carbon Reduction Projects

4.1 Operational Carbon Reduction

- Fleet electrification: phased transition from petrol/diesel engineer fleet vehicles to electric and hybrid alternatives, prioritising highest-mileage vehicles first
- Renewable energy: commitment to procuring 100% renewable electricity for office premises
- Digital operations: elimination of paper-based processes across job management, compliance documentation and customer communications — fully digital workflows via our job management platform
- Waste reduction: segregation and recycling of installation waste on all sites; responsible disposal of old boilers and appliances
- Supply chain engagement: working with principal supply chain partners to understand and reduce their emissions, with preference given to suppliers who can demonstrate a carbon reduction commitment

4.2 Carbon Reduction Through Our Delivered Works

The most significant contribution Elite Energy makes to national carbon reduction is through the measures we install. Every project we complete reduces the energy consumption and carbon emissions of the property concerned. Key delivery programmes include:

- ECO4 / Boiler Upgrade Scheme: whole-house retrofit including solid wall insulation, air source heat pumps, solar PV and cavity wall insulation — each property subject to pre and post SAP assessment (via Elmhurst) quantifying the carbon saving achieved
- Warm Home Discount (WHD) boiler replacement: replacement of inefficient gas boilers with modern high-efficiency condensing systems, reducing fuel consumption and carbon emissions for fuel-poor households
- Solar PV and battery storage: generation of clean renewable electricity at point of use, reducing grid electricity demand and associated Scope 2 emissions for occupants
- Air source heat pumps: replacement of fossil fuel heating with low-carbon alternatives, delivering significant Scope 1 reductions for occupants
- PAS 2035:2023 compliance: all retrofit works delivered in accordance with PAS 2035, ensuring measures are correctly specified, installed and verified for long-term performance

5. Reporting and Review

Elite Energy ECO Ltd commits to reviewing and updating this Carbon Reduction Plan annually. Progress against targets will be reported in our annual Carbon Reduction Plan update, published on our website and made available to clients and procurement bodies on request.

We will measure and report our emissions in accordance with the GHG Protocol and will seek independent verification of our reported figures as our emissions measurement matures.

This plan will be reviewed and updated no later than 30 November each year, aligned to our financial year end.

6. Declaration

Elite Energy ECO Ltd confirms that the information set out in this Carbon Reduction Plan is accurate to the best of our knowledge and belief, and that we are committed to achieving the targets set out above.

We understand that this plan may be verified by the contracting authority and that we will be expected to report on progress against our commitments as part of contract management.
